
REPORT ON STUDENTS' SEMINAR ON 6th & 7th January 2022 B.A .5th SEMESTER HONOURS

The following titles were listed for each group:


- MAJOR TYPES OF WORLD BIOME.






REPORT ON CELEBRATION OF MATHEMATICS DAY




REPORT ON WORKSHOP


- 1. Smriti Tamang, 6th semester (social media: Boon or curse?)


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REPORT ON SEMINAR CONDUCTED BY M/S FLYWAYY, SILIGURI
