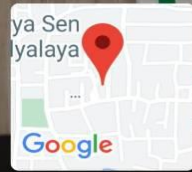

Dr. Raja Routh, Secretary, Jalpaiguri Science and Nature Club glorified the chair of the speaker of the day. Dr. P.K. Mishra, Principal of Surya Sen Mahavidyalaya, Sri Jayanta Moulik , president of GB, Ward Councillor, members of Eco Club and other faculties and students were present at the occasion. Dr.Routh started with the reason behind starting of observation of this particular day 50 years ago by UNEP.As we are living in Siliguri, the terai region of Himalaya, in spite of that this year we are facing 38°C, is it expected? In North Bengal we have 5 National Parks but still the temperature is rising. One of the popular environmentalists based on North Bengal, the speaker made us aware about the current land condition of Tillotama Kolkata. He also added how some common people may contribute towards nature by not using any synthetic raw materials for the production of attires. The observation was ended up by planting trees at the college premises with the pledge of taking care of those saplings individually.

The theme for the day was "Beat Plastic Pollution". Resource person for the event Dr Raja Routh, former Environmentalist and a Banga Ratna awardee and the Secretary of the Jalpaiguri Science and Nature Club, elaborated on how we produce, consume and dispose of plastic

"While plastic has many valuable uses, mankind has become addicted to single-use plastic products, with severe environmental, social, economic and health consequences," Dr Routh said. He laid emphasis on small steps to be taken by everyone in curbing the use of plastic and other toxic products that harm environment.

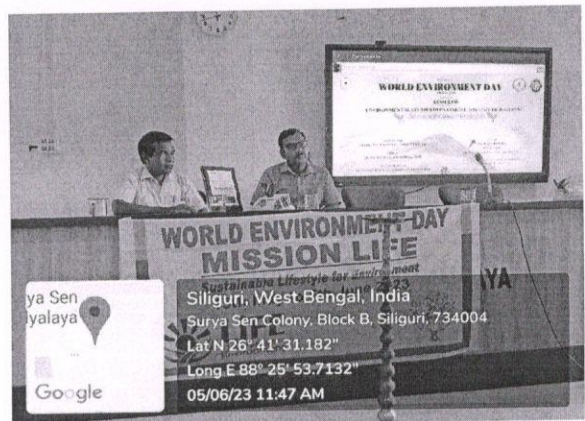
Dr P.K. Mishra, the Principal of the College, pointed out the responsibility of each plastic item, but urged all to reduce its daily use.
