

- The User should share the scientific results with the scientific community through publication in appropriate journals, including Open Access publications, within a reasonable amount of time.
- The User should acknowledge the open access contribution of the RI to his/her research project in every publication based on the results obtained at the RI. If appropriate, the staff of the RI that enhanced the results should also be acknowledged. In cases when the scientists or engineers of the facility contributed significantly to the success of the User's project, the User should consider including them as coauthors on the resulting scientific publications.

As large part of the public support to the RI is given in the expectation that research projects, in addition to their scientific value, may also have direct or indirect economic returns, information about collaboration with industry or other business concerns is important and should be shared with the RI, which will keep it confidential, using it only for statistical purposes without reference to the partners involved.

We are pleased to invite you to Trieste, Italy from 5 to 22 November 2021, under the ICTP-Elettra Users Programme, to participate in project 20210558 at Sincrotrone Trieste (Italy).

ICTP will offer you:

- a prepaid travel ticket West Bengal, India Trieste, Italy West Bengal, India, according to the ICTP travel standards;
- 2. an airport transfer from your airport of arrival to the ICTP guest house;
- 3. accommodation and meals at an ICTP guest house, for a period of 10 days, so you can undertake your mandatory self-isolation period upon your arrival;
- 4. a daily allowance of Euro 71 for each night of stay in Trieste, up to a maximum of 7 nights, once your self-isolation period has been concluded, so you can cover your accommodation and living expenses for the remainder of your stay.
